During the past year, Patriot Scientific has acquired several technologies, including its flagship Crossflo DataExchange® platform (CDX) which facilitates secure, standards-based data sharing among disparate data sources in mission-critical applications. This portfolio represents a proven solution for delivering some of the nation's earliest and most innovative data exchange projects, including one of the first interagency data-sharing initiatives incorporating the Global Justice XML Data Model (GJXDM) across multiple levels of local, state and federal government. "We believe this is a good time in the growth of the company to consolidate our solutions under a single brand to offer our customers our entire knowledge base, product lines and deep industry expertise in the sectors we serve," said Rick Goerner, Patriot Scientific's President and CEO. "The PDSG solutions help guide these mission-critical entities through the complexities of data-sharing initiatives so that these organizations can be better prepared to act on threats to our nation and to make better, more-informed decisions."

Name Change Reflects Market Focus

"We believe PDSG best captures the focus of our current capabilities as well as our future plans to continue expanding in the data sharing market," said Renney Senn, PDSG's President. "There are multiple drivers for our expansion. Healthcare reform, for example, is being propelled by urgent needs for increased quality of medical care delivery and having immediate access to vital medical information at the point of care.
